

## Policy on Projects with Partner Organisations

In the pursuit of its objects, The Nick Webber Memorial Trust for Malawi will not provide financial or other support for projects that the Trustees consider inimical to the just pursuit of those objects.

For example, the Trust will not provide any support for projects that involve either of the following elements:

- ❖ Misleading information about the prevention or treatment of any medical condition, and such other detrimental teaching as the active discouragement of the use of condoms and femidoms as a means of preventing transmission of sexually transmitted infections.
- ❖ Discrimination between potential beneficiaries on grounds other than relative social disadvantage, including discrimination consequent upon packaging the service with the lifestyle of a particular religion, encouragement to convert to a particular religion, or encouragement to join a particular political party or movement.

Consideration of potential projects will involve analysis of ways in which the pursuit of the project might turn out to be detrimental to the just pursuit of the Trust's objects, including but not exhausted by the above examples.

The Trustees will seek written clarifications from any potential partner organisation on any issues to which this policy pertains.
